Farnham Common Cricket Club Summer Program:

As part of the Eco Committee's work this year, we have chosen to focus on improving our school grounds by tackling littering. When talking to other children around the school, we realised that lots of us are concerned about littering so we have decided to take action and get involved in Keep Britain Tidy's Great Big School Clean (21 March - 6 April). The campaign is our country's biggest mass-action environmental campaign; last year, hundreds of thousands of litter-heroes took part and 95% of them said that they had improved their local community and felt great doing it.

As a school, we have pledged that our school will pick at least 200 bags of litter. To meet this target, we will be organising litter picks at playtime around the school and in the local community. Children can also complete their own litter-pick with friends or family as part of the Great Big School Clean, which could be used as evidence for the volunteering section of Junior Challenge, too.
