## Key Knowledge

The four countries and the capital cities of the United Kingdom are:

- England - London
- Scotland - Edinburgh
- Wales - Cardiff
- Northern Ireland - Belfast

The five oceans are the Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Southern and Arctic.

The seven continents are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Oceania.

Hot areas of the world are located closer to the Equator and cold areas of the world are located closer to the North and South Poles.

## Vocabulary

<b>Continent</b>	A large solid area of land, separated from others by water or other natural features.
<b>Ocean</b>	A huge body of salty water.
<b>Equator</b>	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth that divides it into two equal halves.
<b>North Pole</b>	The northernmost point on planet Earth which is located in the Arctic Ocean.
<b>South Pole</b>	The southernmost point on planet Earth which is located within Antarctica.
<b>Antarctica</b>	The southernmost continent which is the coldest place on Earth.
<b>The Sahara</b>	A desert on the continent of Africa. It is the largest hot desert in the world.
