Spelling Activities

Choose an activity from this sheet to help your child learn their spelling words. Try to choose different activities each week to keep spelling fun!

Magnetic Letters

Spell the words using magnetic letters, wooden letters, letter cards or letter tiles.



Write the word on the ground outside using chalk or water and paintbrushes.

Playdough Words

Use alphabet cutters or make letters to spell your words using playdough.



Play a spelling game – number your spelling words 1-6. Roll a dice and spell the word that matches the number you roll.



Spell the word out loud using letter names. You could say it quietly, shout it, sing it, rap it or use a funny voice.

Sing it or say it

Look, Cover, Write, Check.

Write the words on cards and say how to spell the words. Cover the words and write them down. Check to see if you spelt them correctly.

Fill a baking tray with paint, shaving foam, sand or flour. Practise writing your spelling words with your finger.



Silly Sentences

Write each word in a sentence or a silly sentence. Don't forget a full stop and capital letter.



Rainbow Writing

Write your words in one colour then write them again over the top in another colour. Repeat until each letter looks like a rainbow!

Bounce or catch a ball as you spell out each word.
Can you keep bouncing until you have spelt all your words?



Build It

Make the spelling words using pipe-cleaners, or write each letter on a sticker and put them onto Lego bricks to build the words.



Play a game of hangman with your spelling words.
Who will get the most right?
